Dear Secretary Burwell,

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on proposed policy changes to the Federal Medicaid Assistance Percentage (FMAP) for American Indians and Alaska Natives (AI/AN) for services by a provider that is not affiliated with IHS or a Tribal facility. I support the expansion of the FMAP to 100 percent for AI/AN Medicaid beneficiaries.

Wyoming currently receives the standard 50% state/federal FMAP. Greater flexibility in defining IHS services leaves Wyoming more financial resources to support positive health outcomes for American Indians where health disparities exceed national trends for AI/AN populations. The American Indian population in Wyoming grew by 24% over the last decade. Savings generated from the proposed change would support efforts for quality healthcare and improved health outcomes for AI/AN.

I ask you to support this proposed change. Thank you for your consideration.
